This is to certify that the above list contains the true names of the men composing a volunteer company made up this day at Elyton, Jefferson County for the purpose of marching against Mexico. And they do hereby report themselves in readiness to the Governor of the State to march at his warning.

Elyton 16 May 1846

Moses Kelly, Capt. of Jefferson Volunteers

On 30 May, Moses Kelly wrote the Governor that he had been unable "to raise my company to the number required by the War Department".
