Directions:	This cemetery was not inventoried recently and the location was not verified; the information was taken from other sources. From the intersection of Allison-Bonnett Memorial Parkway (a.k.a. Warrior River Road) and Tin Mill Road, go 1.5 miles north on Till Mill Road "near the entrance to Tin Mill, U. S. Steel. Was established by 1835 and used until 1916. Cemetery is kept locked and records were copied from WPA records."
