Turn left onto Goodsprings Road then turn right onto Tutwiler Road and go 4 and 7/10 of a mile. Turn right onto Cedar Lake Road and go 1.4 miles and turn right onto Gross Road. Go about 1/10 of a mile the cemetery is on the left (west) side of Gross Road.
