

# Gwin Cemetery

<b>Location:</b>	Township 18 South Range 7 West Section 35 Rough estimate of GPS location: N 33° 25' 48" or 33.430188 W 87° 14' 41" or -87.244771	
<b>Directions:</b>	Go 4.8 miles on Lock 17 Road (County Road 54) from the intersection of Camp Oliver Road and Lock 17 Road. Turn left while remaining on Lock 17 Road for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Betty Hill Road (County Road 15). Note: Betty Hill Road is 6.3 miles from the Camp Oliver Road and Lock 17 Road intersection. Go 7/10 of a mile on Betty Hill Road. The cemetery is located on the left (east) side of the road.
