

Humphries Cemetery

Location:	Township 18 South Range 7 West Section 30 In the northeast corner of the intersection of Lock 17 Road and Bruce Shaw Road. Approximate Latitude/Longitude: N 33° 27' 15.27" or 33.454243 W 87° 18' 4.87" or -87.301354 A short distance east from the Providence Baptist Church parking lot.	
Directions:	From exit #115 off of I-20/59, go west on Allison-Bonnett Memorial Drive (County Road 56) and cross the railroad tracks and proceed to the traffic light at the intersection with Tin Mill Road (County Road 59). Proceed 25.2 miles west on Allison-Bonnett Memorial Drive as the road changes names to Warrior River Road (County Road 46) and then to Lock 17 Road (County Road 54). The cemetery on the right (when facing the church) about 100 yards east of the church building. In 2008, a trail from the concrete picnic tables was used to get to the cemetery. Note: The Lock 17 Road will bear to the left in two places 1) at the intersection with Camp Oliver Road (10.9 miles to the cemetery) 2) at the intersection with Nancy Bend Road (6.2 miles to the cemetery)
