Location:	Township 19 South Range 5 West Section 16	
Directions:	From Exit 108 on I-20/59 west, go 7/10 west on Academy Drive, turn right on Powder Plant Road and go north 1.6 miles to Johns Road. Turn left onto Johns Road and proceed about west about 3 miles to Tempest Lane. Turn right onto Tempest Lane and then turn right onto Tree Top Lane. The Greater St. Paul Baptist Church is on the left, cemetery to the right of the church.	
Miscellaneous Information:	Cemetery is very poor condition, several markers partially obscured by silt, many white wooden crosses flat on ground. Inventoried by James E. and Linda Vines Hardy.
