<b>Directions:</b>	From the intersection of Hueytown Road & Virginia Drive (County Road 29), go west on Virginia Drive for 4.4 miles crossing 15 <sup>th</sup> Street. Valley Creek Cemetery is on the right (north) side of Virginia Drive and there is a dirt road leading from Valley Creek Cemetery to the Virginia Mines Cemetery on the western edge of Valley Creek Cemetery.	
<b>Miscellaneous Information:</b>	Believed to be predominately an African-American cemetery.  Cemetery is divided into two sections by a wooded area– a lower section that is less than one tenth of a mile from the upper section. Surveyed by James E. and Linda Vines Hardy on 12 Nov 2006.
