

West Pratt (Bethel) Cemetery

Location:	Township 16 South Range 6 West Section 25 GPS Coordinates of dirt road entrance N 33° 36' 46.83" or 33.613007 W 87° 7' 16.42" or -87.121228	
Directions:	Cemetery is located near the old mining community of Praco. (Praco was an acronym for the Pratt Consolidated Coal Company.) At the time of this census, access to the cemetery was by on-foot. Cemetery is northeast of the intersection of Birmingham Road (Ala. Hwy 269) and Alliance Road (County Road 81). A 1982 General Highway Map of Jefferson County prepared by the State of Alabama Highway Department showed a Pleasant Grove Church near the cemetery.	
Miscellaneous Information:	"This cemetery was used by the New Bethel Baptist Church until the 1940s, when the church was turned over to the blacks of Praco. When the blacks began to meet in the church, they started a new cemetery that was nearer to the building." Source: <i>Journey Into the Past</i> by Barry J. McCleney.
